This workshop deals with **Multiple images** where several ideas relating to an idea can be illustrated in one painting. This unique, step by step method allows individual creativity and personal expression. Using traditional methods of paint application, we will "break up" the picture plane into different fragments. Contained in each fragment is a piece of the puzzle. The "story" may be about a subject, or a mood - calming, whimsical , or joyful.

Please note: This workshop is for artists who already know basic watercolour techniques.

Materials- Your usual watercolour supplies (paints, palette, brushes- 2 water containers (sour cream containers work well), hb pencil, vinyl eraser, tissues, optional- masking fluid & a tool for applying it., Arches 140 lb cold pressed paper 15" x 22" or 15"x11" . A support for under the painting and masking tape to attach the paper

step 1- choose a theme or topic such as : toys, animals, kitchen utensils (- In the examples shown are "fish" and and a "pear orchard"

For inspiration- bring photographs or a small object to fit your theme (a wooden toy, a carved bird, a silver spoon or teacup)

Do not preplan your art. I will show you various ways to start. Let the fun begin!
