Manufacturers have expanded the range of colours beyond the capabilities of artists to keep up with the changes. Too many colours or combining pigments that do not work together can be eliminated by working with triads. In this workshop we will explore how to create triads and how to use them to create harmonious paintings.

Supplies;

Paint: your usual palette plus the following

1. hansa yellow, quinacridone magenta, phthalo blue

(green shade)

2. raw sienna, burnt sienna, paynes gray

Brushes, water containers, pencil, eraser, cold press 140 lb paper
